We had the sad news during November of the passing of one of cycling's all-time greats, Raymond Poulidor, who has died at the age of 83. His career began before I was born,

turning professional in 1960 and winning Milan-San Remo the following year. He won the Vuelta a Espana in 1964 and a total of 189 wins during his 18-year career, but is - probably unfairly - best known for *not* winning the Tour De France (2nd three times and 3rd five times). This was mainly due to the fact that his career coincided with those of Jacques Anquetil and Eddy Merckx, who won it five times each.

Even so, his "*Poupoularité*" outshone Anquetil's. "The more unlucky I was, the more the public liked me and the more money I earned" he said. He attended every Tour de France since his debut in 1961 until this year, ironically being often called on to present the yellow jersey despite having never worn it himself!

I'm looking forward to the official start of this year's Christmas festivities – the Christmas Club Run in Richmond Park this Sunday December 1. Meet at the car park near to Roehampton Gate at 10am. It's worth arriving early if you're coming by car as the **car** park fills up quite early on, then get in a few laps of the Park (on your bike and NOT in the car), before a cup of mulled wine and mince pies, and an overpriced breakfast in the café.
