#### TIME TRAILS



# WHEN DID I JOIN

Having recently posted the De Laune membership cards, together with the DLN, some members have queried the joining date shown on these cards. Let me first say that Steve Carter-Smith completes the cards with the information available to him. I have personally spent a considerable amount of time checking the dates and have come up with the following information.

Up until the end of 1948, the method used for election of members was that they were proposed, seconded and, if successful was elected on their first application put before a committee meeting. However, at a committee meeting on 21st January 1949, a change in the method of election was proposed, seconded and carried "that all new members serve a probationary period of three months, and that their names be put before the committee three successive times for consideration before membership is granted. Such members however can race and take prizes during this period".

This procedure for joining the club seems to have fallen by the wayside in the late 1950s. Mike Peel appears to have been the last member to have been elected in this manner, after which the procedure seems to have reverted to the pre-1949 formula, although no specific date for the changeover is apparent.


These members are not shown as having been formally elected at any committee meeting; however, Arthur is mentioned in the DLN

on the 3rd April 1949 and also as being present at a committee meeting held on the 15th September 1949; Derek's name first appears as being present at a committee meeting on the 13th October 1949; Roy on the 21st October 1954 and Reg on the 17th September 1956.

The subscription books only record the <u>year</u> that subs are paid and not the <u>actual date</u>, which makes it difficult to ascertain whether the joining dates shown above for these members are correct.

If anyone has any queries on the above, please let me know and I will endeavour to provide further information. However, it is my intention to work my way through the complete membership list which will prove somewhat more difficult as a large section of members have broken service, ie they have left and rejoined the club at some stage.
